

Fawkham Village Hall Management Committee



Final Report

It was with deep regret and sadness that the Fawkham Village Hall Management Committee was dissolved on 14 November 2019.

The Reason for this closure was that the management committee was unable to sustain itself with active volunteers to take on key roles. In spite of advertising by door to door leaflets and using Fawkham Community Facebook page it has proven impossible to fill any of the positions of Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer or Bookings Secretary. This has been an exhaustive process using local means. The existing incumbents wished to each retire after the many years of service to the committee.

The following resolution was passed. This transferred the management of the Fawkham Village Hall back to the Fawkham Parish Council acting as sole trustees. The Fawkham Village Hall Management Committee (FVHMC) was therefore dissolved:

Fawkham Village Hall Management Committee hereby resolves to make the following changes to the Trust Deed made the 19th October 1989, using statutory powers under section 280 of the Charities Act 2011.

The Trust Deed shall be read and construed as if:

- 1. Paragraph 1. 2. (2) of the Schedule, Administration by Committee, is amended to read: The Charity shall be administered in conformity with the provisions of this deed by Fawkham Parish Council (hereinafter called "the Trustee") which shall be the sole charity trustee of the charity within the meaning of section 46 of the Charities Act 1960.*
- 2. Paragraphs 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the Schedule are deleted*
- 3. All references to "the Committee" within paragraphs 8 to 19 inclusive of the Schedule shall be read and construed as "the Trustee"*

The retiring FVHMC would like to thank all of its volunteers and supporters, over many years, for their help in running supporting and the Fawkham Village Hall.

The retiring FVHMC would also like to sincerely thank the Fawkham Parish Council for its help and support and wish them a very successful future for the Hall.
