primary and secondary schools in the District to attend an online interactive quiz about being safe on line.


There were over 15 classes and schools from across the District that attended.

We Doorstep criminals call on unsuspecting householders offering deals you can't refuse! But, you should. If you accept their work, the chances are you'll pay much more than you'd bargained for with poor, unnecessary and sometimes dangerous work.

Common phrases used by rogue traders and bogus callers which are not true include:

We've been working on your neighbour's property...

I've worked on your property in the past, do you need further work?

I was driving past when I noticed loose tiles on your roof...

We have recently been released from prison and we're on probation...
